



Format for Poster Abstract

General:

1. Title (capitalized)
2. Under the title, list and underline the author(s)' names(s) and mailing address of the first author. Omit credentials and job titles.
3. The body of the abstract should be no more than one page. The type should be a 12 pt font. Abstracts will be included in the handout book distributed to all conference attendees.

For RESEARCH POSTERS

Summary of research of 150-300 words, to include:

1. Statement of problem: Purpose, significance, and theoretical base
2. Methodology: Design, sample size, methods of data collection, and analysis
3. Results/findings: Major findings
4. Implications: Conclusions and recommendations
5. Support for research: Grants or other funding

For PI/CLINICAL PRACTICE INNOVATIONS POSTERS

Summary of 150-300 words, to include:

1. Purpose/objectives
2. Content

3. Strategies for implementation
4. Outcomes

ABSTRACT PREPARATION CHECKLIST

For your convenience, the following checklist has been provided to use in preparing your abstract.

- Title (capitalized)
- Below title, list and underline author(s)' names and mailing address of first author only (omit credential and job title)
- Body of abstract printed in 12 pt font
- Abstract is no longer than a single page
- One copy of abstract submitted with author(s)' names and addresses
- Three copies submitted without names and addresses
- One copy of Poster Information Sheet submitted with each abstract
- Appropriate category, research or PI/clinical innovation, checked on Poster Information Sheet
- Preferred mailing address checked on Poster Information Sheet
- All submission must be received by August 15, 2006.
